*The Mission of the Kingdom of Serbia and the Kingdom of Serbia, Croatia and Slovenia
to Denmark and Norway – Copenhagen 1918-1929*

Summary

In the last year of World War I the Kingdom of Serbia opened a Mission in Copenhagen which, after the unification, was transformed into the Mission of the Kingdom of Serbia, Croatia and Slovenia, but the Representative, with the exception of Denmark, was accredited to Norway as well. Besides following the political and social situation in these countries, the main activities of the Mission included cooperation with the institutions of these countries regarding humanitarian aid for Serbian prisoners and interns in Germany and Austria-Hungary, as well as for Serbian citizens caught in the whirlpool of the civil war in Russia. Due to financial reasons the Mission was closed at the end of 1920.
