*Digitizing of Photograph Collection of the Cabinet of the President of the Republic*

*Summary*

The Museum of Yugoslavian History had started the digitalization project in 2011, which included photo material related to the political aspects between former Yugoslavia and non-aligned states. The result was digitalized data base of photo archive. This paper is trying to explain the selection, scanning and preservation processes, together with setting up the Web platform. The data base itself consists of more than 150.000 photographs, 5.420 names, 1.083 geographical locations and 360 key words, with possibility to be enlarged and improved by entering new data. Mentioned Web platform proved to be a successful and useful for research and operational data manipulation. This and similar projects could be encouragement for all of cultural institutions in the Republic of Serbia to preserve their tangible and intangible heritage through digitalization process. Foregoing Web platform essentially follows similar solutions of Web archives from the rest of the world and can be a good starting point for further application of these solutions.
