*Web Application “Inventory” in the Archives of Yugoslavia*

*Summary*

The subject of this paper is web presentation “Inventory” that is at the local network of the Archives of Yugoslavia accessible to both archivists from the Archives and to the users of the archival material in the reading room of the Archives. Its aim is to provide faster and qualitative access to the information resources – inventory of fonds of the Archives of Yugoslavia. Archivists working in the Archives will be able to: apply for the work in application and to choose the fond for work where they can introduce data, update them, delete them and print them, while all the users of application will be able to: go through the data of the chosen fond, sort certain data and examine all separate unities of the inventory (general data regarding the fond, units of description, classification scheme, indexes of archival material, register books, card files, personal documents and photographs) within the chosen fond or within all fonds. Besides those separate units of the inventory it is possible to search especially processed fonds AJ-65” Ministry of Trade and Industry of the Kingdom of Yugoslavia ”as well as dossier of the fond AJ-17 “Ministry of Industry of FNRJ.

More qualitative access to inventory base implies that the users after searching units of description (name and contents of units of description, year of document within unit of description, language and type of a document) obtain as a search result data on the screen with marked words that they enter for searching. Besides, there is a possibility to read original documents which belong to the found units of description, right on the screen in digitized form. This is for the time being possible to do just for two collections: AJ-37 “Stojadinović Milan” and AJ-80 “Jovanović Jovan – Pižon”
