*Collection of Photographs from the Archives of Yugoslavia
– The Second World War and the Post-war Period –*

Summary

Cross section of the photograph collection created in the period of the Kingdom of Yugoslavia was presented in the last edition of the magazine *Arhiv*, while this edition deals with fonds and collections of photos created during the Second World War, period of Socialistic Yugoslavia and the State Union of Serbia and Montenegro. Photos from thirty fonds /collections, respectfully over 35.000 photos that were singled out in the process of arranging archival fonds and the collections of manuscripts, received as a gift, belong to this period. Along with arranging and processing, significant fonds and collections were digitized, so that four fonds were completely digitized, whereas fond 101- the State Commission for Investigation of Crimes of Occupying Forces and their Helpers, being of special importance. Maps, posters and other printed material were singled out and forwarded to the Library of the Archives for further processing and preservation. In order to make it more concise, basic data regarding quantity, accessibility, type of archival material and degree of arrangement are given bellow the name of the fond by the icons.
